#### Safety Information for quests:

Please leave your room closing the door behind you and exit through the main entrance onto Leeson Close the fire assembly point is located in the car park adjacent.

Please leave your room closing door behind you and exit the entrance onto Fitzwilliam place. The fire assembly point is located next to the Colombian Embassy at 29 Fitzwilliam Place.
